## Abstract Requirements:

- Title: Clear and descriptive
- Authors: Full names, affiliations, and contact information
- Abstract body: Maximum 350 words (excluding figures and tables) organized into introduction, methods, results and conclusion
- Figures/Tables: Up to three
- Keywords: Up to five

## Guidelines for Submission:

- Use standard abbreviations and SI units. Define any unusual abbreviations in parentheses after the first use.
- Presentations must be balanced and contain no promotional content for commercial purposes.
- Submissions may not contain patient names, hospital ID numbers, or any other identifying information.

- **Deadline for submission: February 13, 2026**
